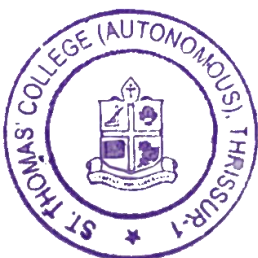

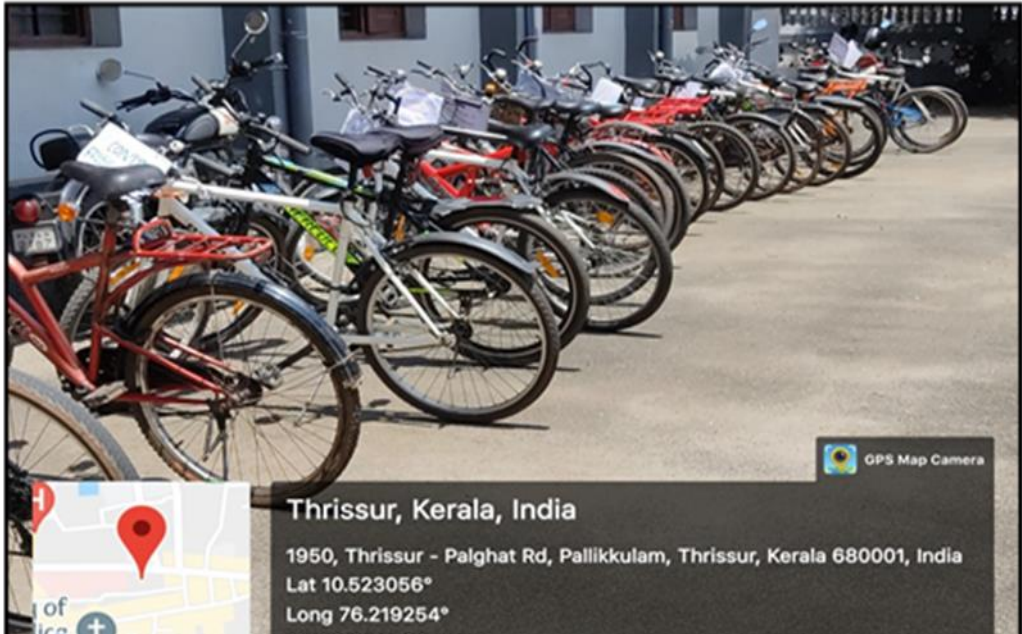

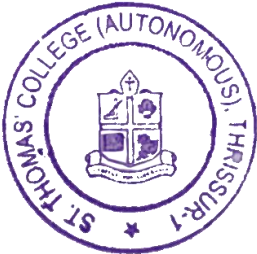

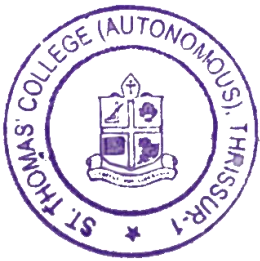

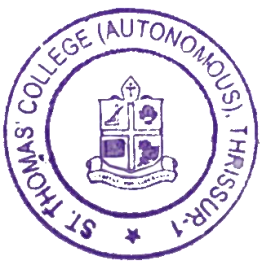

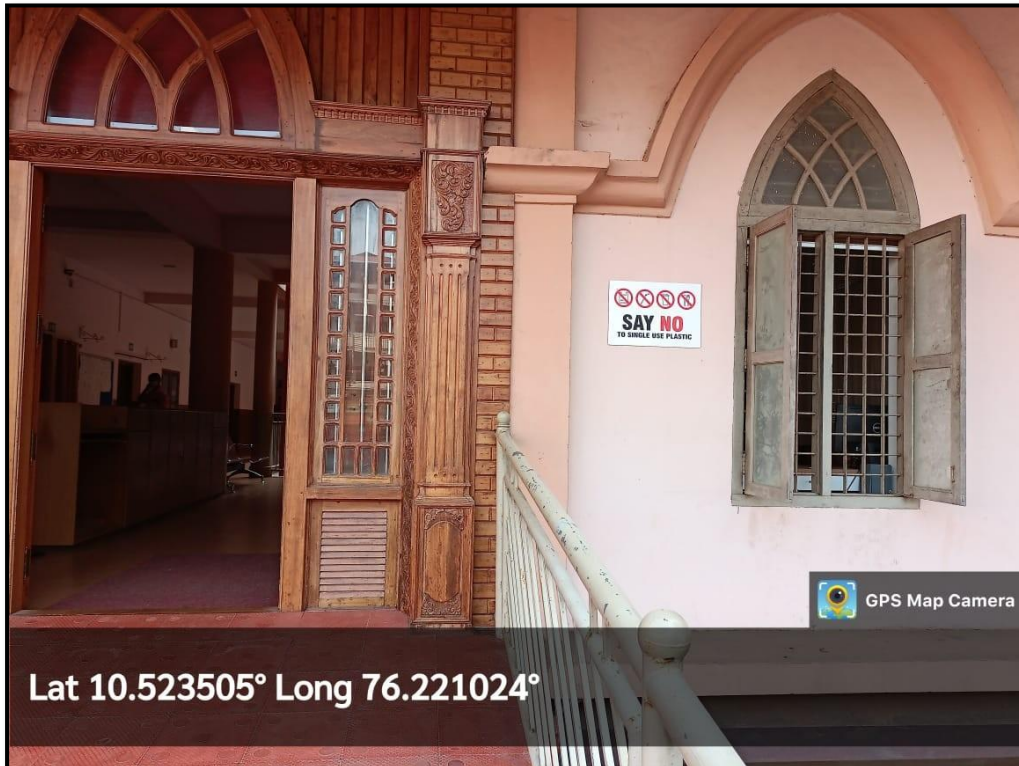

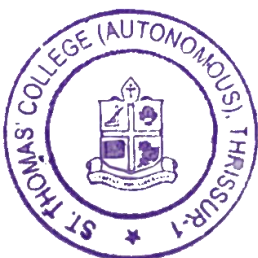


Board indicating Single used plastic banned in Administrative Block



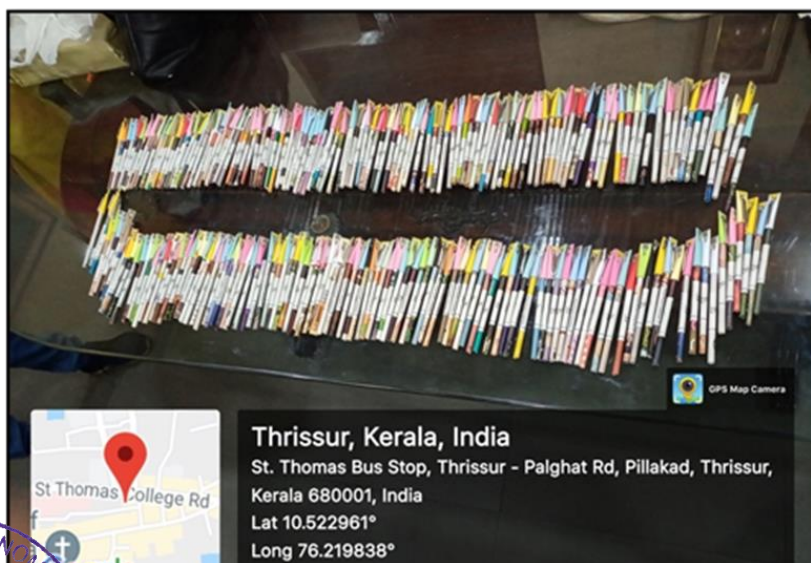
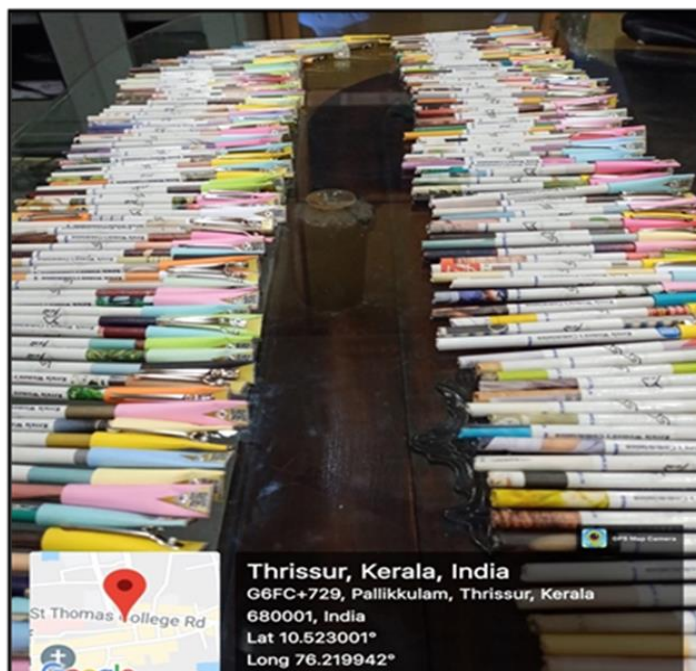

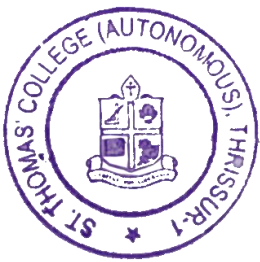

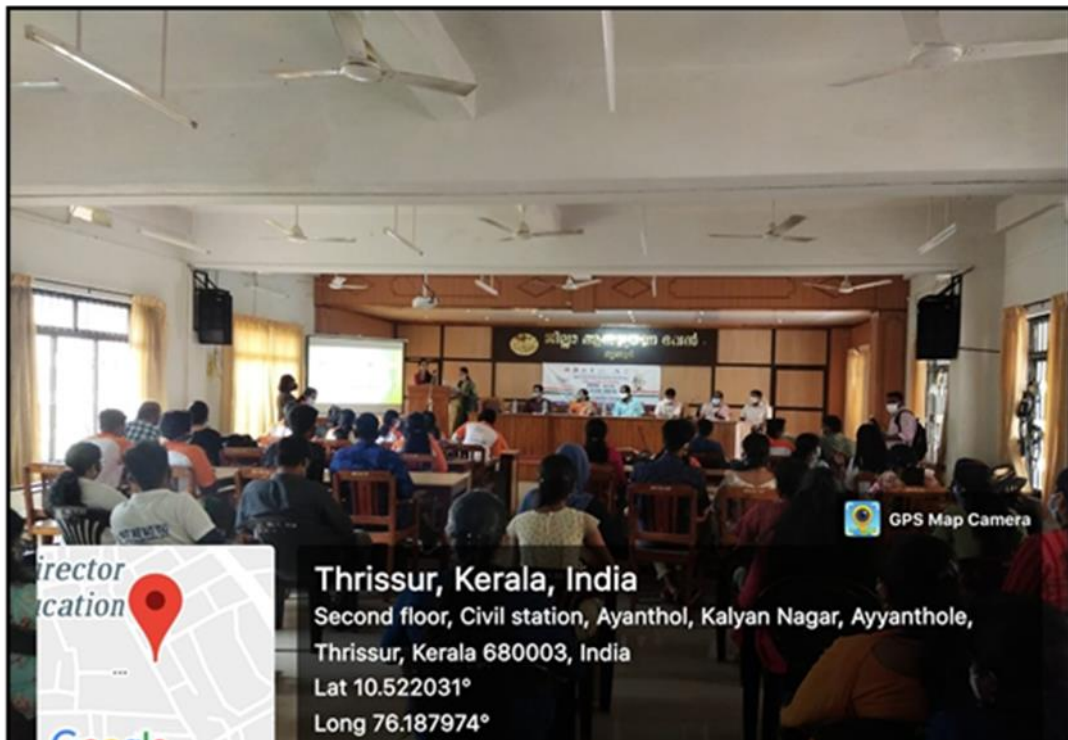




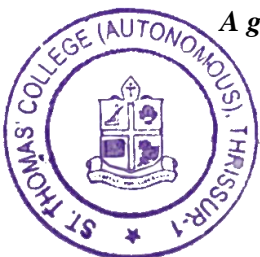
