ORDER

As per University Order read as (1), sanction was accorded to implement the recommendations of the subcommittee of the Syndicate for considering the issue of granting permanent affiliation to the courses which were started years back for which the details cannot be traced out.

As per the provisions of Clause (2) of the University Order of even No. dated 11.12.2009 in the case of those courses in Government and aided affiliated colleges permanent affiliation, if needed, can be granted on the basis of specific request from the concerned colleges and after conducting an inspection, without levying fee or fine and as per clause (2) of the said U.O, in the case of courses started since the inspection of the University upto 1997-98 academic year in Government and Aided affiliated colleges for which affiliation order could not be traced out, affiliation may be granted on specific request from the concerned college, after inspection and levy of a fee of Rs.2,500/- per course.

Vide paper read as 2nd applications were submitted by the Principals of St.Aloysius College, Elthuruth, Vimala College, Thrissur, St.Thomas' College, Thrissur, Sri Vyasa NSS College, Wadakanchery for permanent affiliation to various courses in the colleges as per clause 1 and 2 of the U.O dated 11.12.2009.

As per paper read as 3rd, the District Level Inspection Commission was entrusted to conduct inspection in St.Aloysius College, Elthuruth, Vimala College, Thrissur, St.Thomas' College, Thrissur, Sri Vyasa NSS College, Wadakanchery and St.Joseph's College, Irinjalakuda. The District Level Inspection Commission recommended to grant permanent affiliation to the UG and PG courses in St.Aloysius College, Elthuruth, Vimala College, Thrissur, St.Thomas' College, Thrissur, Sri Vyasa NSS College, Wadakanchery.

The Syndicate of the University vide item read as (4) considered the question of granting permanent affiliation to various UG and PG courses in view of the recommendation of the District Level Inspection Commission and resolved to grant the same.

Sanction has therefore been accorded for granting permanent affiliation to the following courses in the respective colleges with intake noted below.

As per the directions of the government, University vide letter read (3) above and informed the colleges that they can start the courses subject to the conditions stipulated by the University. Accordingly the management of certain colleges have given the undertaking stating that they will abide by the conditions of the University and Government.

Sanction is therefore, accorded by the Vice-Chancellor granting provisional affiliation to start new courses in colleges as detailed below for the year 2001-2002.

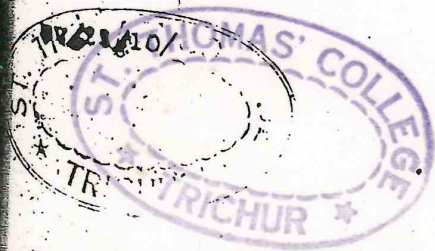

ORDER

1. The Principal Secretary to Govt., Department of Higher Education, Govt. of Kerala has informed, vide letters read as second, that the Government have announced in the Budget speech

2020-21, for commencement of innovative and interdisciplinary courses in Affiliated Colleges. An Expert Committee was constituted with Prof. Sabu Thomas as the Chairman, to make recommendations on new programmes. It was also informed that Government have requested the Hon'ble Chancellor to extend the date of submission of applications for new courses till 31/08/2020 and requested University to submit separate proposals to the Hon'ble Chancellor for seeking extension of time.

2. Accordingly, the Hon'ble Chancellor was requested, vide letter read as fourth, for granting extension of last date for submission of application for starting innovative interdisciplinary programmes in affiliated colleges for the academic year 2020-21, upto 31.08.2020, as resolved by the Syndicate at its meeting held on 14.07.2020 vide paper read as third.

3. The Principal Secretary to Govt., Department of Higher Education, vide letter read as fifth, directed to call for applications from accredited aided and Govt. colleges and unaccredited aided colleges started by Scheduled Tribe Trusts, for commencement of innovative inter-disciplinary courses as suggested by the Committee constituted for the purpose.

4. The Principal Secretary to Governor, vide letter read as sixth, informed that if the Vice Chancellor intends to invite applications for starting new generation courses in affiliated colleges during the academic year 2020-21 on the basis of Government letter or otherwise, the Vice Chancellor may exercise first, the independent powers conferred on him as per Section 10(13) of the Calicut University Act, 1975. Thereafter, the Vice Chancellor may process and refer the eligible cases to the Hon'ble Chancellor for extension of the time period within which the Syndicate shall consider the applications for affiliation as per Section 56 (2) of the Calicut University Act, 1975. Also, in view of the above, the Vice Chancellor may take necessary action and keep that office informed about the action taken in the matter.

5. In compliance with the above direction, a notification was issued inviting applications from NAAC accredited Aided and Government Colleges and Aided Colleges started by Scheduled Caste and Community Trusts, even if unaccredited, within the jurisdiction of the University of Calicut, for starting additional innovative interdisciplinary programmes in arts and science stream for the Academic year 2020-21.

6. The Government, vide letter read as ninth, extended the date of receiving recommendations of the University on applications for commencing the programmes to 25.09.2020.

7. The applications received from colleges have been considered by the Syndicate and resolved, vide paper read as tenth, to forward recommendations for commencement of innovative interdisciplinary programmes in Govt./Aided Arts & Science Colleges to the Government and thus, recommendations of the University were forwarded to the Government, vide letters read as eleventh, for obtaining views of the Government as stipulated in Calicut University First Statutes, 1977.

8. Administrative Sanction was accorded by the Govt. of Kerala for starting innovative interdisciplinary programmes at Govt./Aided Arts & Science Colleges affiliated to University of Calicut during the academic year 2020-'21, vide G.O. read as thirteenth, based on the recommendations of the University.

9. As directed by the Hon'ble Chancellor, vide letter read as sixth, eligible applications along with recommendations were forwarded to the Hon'ble Chancellor vide letter read as fifteenth, for extending the period for consideration of applications by the Syndicate. As permission was granted by the Hon'ble Chancellor vide letter read as sixteenth, the Syndicate considered the applications for starting innovative interdisciplinary programmes.

10. As decided by the Syndicate vide paper read as fourteenth, a meeting of Principals of applicant colleges was held on 07.12.2020 and as per U.O. read as eighteenth, it has been ordered to grant provisional affiliation, in first phase, to the programmes for which approved syllabi are available in the University. Meanwhile, General & Academic- IV Branch and the Monitoring Committee constituted for observing the developments in implementation of decisions of the Syndicate in respect of starting innovative interdisciplinary programmes and imparting suggestions, have informed that certain programmes for which approved syllabi are not available can be started with change in nomenclature, if the college concerned are willing to, and the matter was communicated to the colleges concerned.

11. Accordingly, the Principals of the Colleges have uploaded required documents such as affidavit in prescribed format and in stamp paper worth ₹200/- and challan receipt towards remittance of affiliation fee @₹2760/- (Rupees two thousand seven hundred and sixty only) for Govt. Colleges and ₹5515/- (Rupees five thousand five hundred and fifteen only) for Aided Colleges, for granting Provisional Affiliation to innovative interdisciplinary programmes for the academic year 2020-'21, in Centralized College Portal.

12. The Syndicate, at its meeting held on 30.01.2021 has resolved, vide item No.2021.130*, to grant provisional affiliation to the programmes having approved syllabi in the University, if the colleges concerned have uploaded the required documents in the Centralised College Portal and if not, to grant provisional affiliation to the programmes only when the colleges upload the documents in the Centralised College Portal.

13. Considering the matter in detail, sanction has been accorded by the Vice Chancellor, on

03/02/2021, to implement the aforesaid resolution of the Syndicate.

14. Govt. of Kerala have accorded administrative sanction again vide G.Os read as 22nd and 23rd, for starting new programmes in various Govt./Aided Arts & Science Colleges during the academic year 2020-'21.

15. Considering the above, the Hon'ble Chancellor was requested for extension of time for considering the aforesaid applications by the Syndicate, upto 31.03.2021, vide letter read as 24th. As per the notification read as 25th, the Hon'ble Chancellor has extended the period of considering the applications from the said Colleges, by the Syndicate, upto 31.03.2021.

16. In accordance with the decision of the Syndicate vide paper cited 21st, the Vice Chancellor has ordered to grant provisional affiliation to the programmes having approved syllabi in the University, if the Colleges concerned have uploaded required documents in the Centralized College Portal.

17. Thus provisional affiliation was granted to various innovative interdisciplinary programmes in various Govt./Aided Arts & Science colleges which have uploaded required documents in the Centralised College Portal, vide U.Os read as 26th to 31st.

18. The nomenclatures of the programmes sanctioned by the Govt. at certain colleges are changed according to the availability of syllabi in the University, as intimated from G & A IV Branch, based on the meeting held on 19.04.2021. The colleges concerned have intimated their willingness to change the nomenclature of the programmes and uploaded required documents in the Centralized College Portal.

19. Considering exigency of the matter, the Vice Chancellor, on 20/08/2021, ordered for granting provisional affiliation to the programmes as shown below, subject to ratification by the Syndicate.

20. Orders are, therefore, issued for granting provisional affiliation to new programmes in the following Govt./Aided Arts & Science Colleges affiliated to University of Calicut for the academic year 2020-'21 as given below, subject to ratification by the Syndicate.

21. Provisional affiliation granted is subject to the following terms and conditions:

- Affiliation granted is strictly provisional and only for the academic year 2020-21. College has to apply for Continuation of Provisional Affiliation for the ensuing academic year by remitting the fee fixed by the University. Admission to the next academic year shall be made only after obtaining prior permission from the University.
- As stipulated in G.O.(Ms)No.389/2020/HEDN dated 05.11.2020 and G.O.(Ms) No.150/2021/HEDN dated 25.02.2021, no post creation shall be allowed for these courses till 2025. Classes should be run with guest faculties only.
- The management/college should abide by the provisions of the University Act, Statutes and Regulations of the University with regard to admission of students, collection of fee etc.
- Selection and admission shall be made only on the basis of the rules and regulations of the University/Government and on the directions issued by the University/Government from time to time, failing which affiliation granted will automatically be cancelled.
- Conduct of University Examinations of any sort including that of SDE Examinations is compulsory and binding on all colleges affiliated to the University of Calicut.
- The Principal shall strictly follow the approved syllabi, which is available in the University website (www.uoc.ac.in) for selecting the complementary/common courses.

- In the light of the directions of the Supreme Court of India in WP(C) No. 656/1998, the institution shall take appropriate measures for prevention of ragging in any form. In case of failure to prevent such instances, appropriate action including withdrawal of affiliation of the College will be initiated.

2. Continuation of Provisional Affiliation for the year 2019-20 was granted to B.Voc Data Science (50) programme vide the University Order read as second above. Continuation of Provisional Affiliation to BVoc Forensic Science (50) programme for the AY 2019-20 was granted vide University Order read as third above, subject to the condition of submitting the bills of all the books mentioned by the Inspection Commission before the expiry of the period of the academic year 2019-20 and that the application for Continuation of Provisional Affiliation for 2020-21 shall be considered only after submitting the same.

3.
