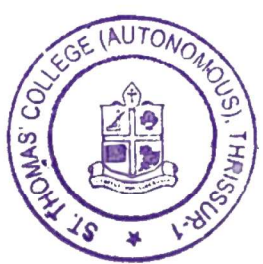

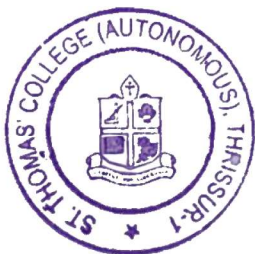

Additionally, participants discovered how to create informative and visually appealing plots and charts using Seaborn, making it easier to uncover patterns and insights within the data.

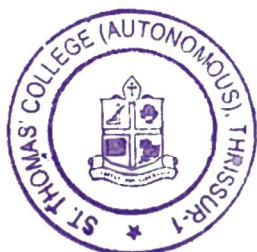

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CPR Training

12-09-2023 & 13-09-2023

Internal Quality Assurance Cell, NCC and NSS of St. Thomas College (Autonomous), Thrissur collaborated with Heart Care Foundation, Kochi to provide free CPR training to the entire second year undergraduate student community of the college. The training was held on 12th and 13th of September, 2023. It consisted of five theory sessions on the Concept of CPR, a self-evaluative pen and paper objective type test and practical training on AI enabled mannequins (TOFU). Each student was given a 2-minute hands on session on the mannequin which provided real time feedback about the quality of compressions through a simple app. 904 persons including students, teachers and non-teaching staff were CPR trained. Heart Care Foundation (HCF), Kochi has conducted many awareness events across the state and has just initiated their activities in Thrissur district. “Education is what remains after you have forgotten everything else you have learnt” said Ms. Limi Rose Tom COO of HCF. She lauded St. Thomas College for pioneering such a mass CPR literacy campaign which no other Kerala or maybe India has forayed into. Dr. Geevar Zachariah, Head of Cardiology Department at Thrissur Mother Hospital, Dr PP Mohanan Head of Cardiology Department at Thrissur Westfort Hospital both renowned cardiologists and Sri Kiran NM, Director of Basic responders and his team handled the sessions. Rev. Dr. Martin, Principal emphasized that students should be upskilled not only in academics and for employment but towards good and responsible citizenship. Dr. Divya George IQAC coordinator, Dr. Joyce Jose General Programme Coordinator, Dr. Sabu AS NCC Officer, Dr. Vimala K John and Dr Joby Paul NSS officers mobilized an efficient team of teacher and student volunteers to ensure the smooth conduct of the training sessions without disrupting the routine work in the college.

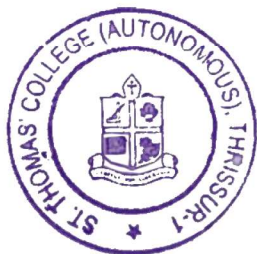

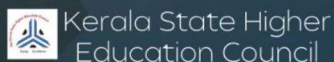

She is the president elect of the Association of Applied Biologists, the general secretary of the Federation of European Societies of Plant Biologists, an elected board member of American Society of Plant Biologists and a member of the French Academy of Agriculture. She serves as editor –in-chief of the renowned journal ‘Food and Energy Security’. Also holds the positions of senior editor of ‘Plant, Cell and Environment Journal’ and associate editor of other esteemed journals like ‘Biochemical Journal’, ‘The Journal of Experimental Biology’ and ‘Physiologia Plantarum’. She discovered the ascorbate-glutathione cycle which is now known as Foyer-Halliwell-Asada Pathway. With over 615 research papers under her belt, she has a current H index of 96 and more than 88,000 citations. She has been included in the Thomson Reuters IP & science authoritative compilation of highly cited researchers for over 10 years and occupies the uppermost 1% position of most often referenced work in the respective field. Rev. Dr. Martin K A, Principal of the College, inaugurated the seminar and also delivered presidential address of the programme. The resource person of the seminar, Prof. Christine Helen Foyer, delivered an erudite lecture in the subject of plant physiology with special emphasize to stress physiology. The title of the lecture was ‘Chloroplast ROS production and stress tolerance’. She made a detailed explanation on how ROS (Reactive Oxygen Species) affects plant metabolism and the role of LEA proteins in stress tolerance. Students and faculties from other departments of the college and also from other colleges participated in the programme. About 160 participants including teachers, post graduate students and research scholars participated in the seminar. The seminar provided vast and deep idea about the stress tolerance mechanisms shown by plants and also how it can be made useful in crop plants.
