Action Taken Report

- 1. Dr C S Biju, Chairman, welcomed the members of the Board of Studies and introduced Dr. Fr. Benny Benedict, Director, Chetana Media Institute, Thrissur(Representative of Industry) and Dr. Denis Joseph Anatty Olakkengil, Associate Professor, Govt. College, Kuttanellur(University Nominee), the new members to the Board of studies.
- 2. Head of the Department presented the feedback on curriculum for the academic year 2022-2023. BOS discussed and analysed the feedback and proposed to include the suggestions in the next revision.
- 3. BOS decided to introduce new programs and courses based on NEP from 2024 considering the following factors:
 - a) Skill development / Employability / Entrepreneurship
 - b) Local/Regional/national/global needs
 - c) Cross cutting issues
 - d) Feedback report on curriculum from 2019 to 2023
- 4. BOS formulated committee for Syllabus revision with Dr. C. S. Biju,HOD as chairman and Biju M A, Dr. Viju M.J, Dr. Stishin K P, Bibin Joseph, and Swathimol K.S. as members. It also decided that the committee will work on syllabus once a clear directive and final syllabi are received from the university.
- 5. BOS decided to conduct at least one Certificate course/Value Added Course for UG and PG students. Certificate course will be organised with special focus on Skill development / Employability / Entrepreneurship.

The BOS recommended to introduce a Certificate Programme for UG students under the auspices of Santhom Institute of Foreign Languages.

The Syllabus revision Committee will finalize the curriculum of value added programmes in the next BOS meeting.
